**Program:** is one that we are most proud of. It is a mentorship and job training program that started in 1980, and is designed to help the lives of men in Orlando "start" in life. The Fresh Start program provides the young men quarterly health check-ups, provides meals, drinks, and transportation, where progress is monitored.

**Medical:** continues to visit our members in hospitals, nursing homes, and other facilities.

**Medical:** provided various medical supplies that have been shipped to hospitals, doctor's examinations, wheelchairs for children, and donations of supplies to hospitals.

**Financial:** more than thousands of dollars in relief efforts locally including Haiti. Funds have been raised for Ho Loung's Missionaries, a Place of Safety and Food in Kingston, Jamaica.

**Education:** provided annually (at our expense) to students between locally and internationally, and into college and meet the admission criteria.

**Assistance:** for several years provided to restore disrepair and water. Assistance was provided to build a two-bedroom house in Jamaica, West Indies. Members were furnished with transportation to the Middle Buxton Inn, Jamaica.

Funds were also donated to the Arthur Wint Basic School in Hanover, Jamaica, towards the purchase of books.

- ◆ **JAAM Youth**—is a youth arm of the Organization. The current members are third generation and are being groomed to lead this organization in the years to come. They have annual field day events every summer and represent the Organization at several dance performances throughout the year. Youth programs such as visiting the elderly and new ideas are ongoing.
- ◆ **Community Activities**—in partnership with the Caribbean American Chamber of Commerce of Florida with several events, such as CAHM (Caribbean American Heritage Month) festivities every June at Lake Eola. We support all sister Organization Ball's in Central Florida, South Florida, and Tampa. We participate in the annual Martin Luther King Parade in Ocoee, FL. Our Black-History-Month celebration is getting bigger and better. We celebrate Jamaica's Heritage Month, and our annual tea party is fast becoming a household event.
